LAKESIDE PLAYERS BURSARY

Amount of the Bursary for 2014: up to \$700.00

APPLICATIONS

Application date: April 1st, 2014

Applicants must provide the Kaatza Lakeside Players with the following information:

- 1) An outline of student's future educational plans
- 2) The post secondary courses they plan to take

CLAIMING

Deadline for claiming: June 30th, 2015

Successful applicants must contact the Kaatza Lakeside Players by the deadline date, with the following information:

- 1) Proof of registration to a post-secondary institution
- 2) Proof of payment to a post-secondary institution.

QUALIFICATIONS

Open to any graduating student from Lake Cowichan Secondary School, who:

- 1) Has academic achievements to qualify them for a scholarship.
- 2) Pursues further education in the arts: see *Eligibility*

ELIGIBILITY

The scholarship is open to any secondary school graduating student who pursues further education in the arts, defined:

- 1) acting, stage or motion pictures
- 2) voice and/or dance, including ballet
- 3) composer
- 4) writing, including:
 - a) playwright
 - b) creative writing
 - c) journalism
- 5) stage crafting, including
 - a) set design
 - b) technical, including light and sound
- 6) stage management, including production and direction.

RULES & GUIDELINES

- 1) The Lake Cowichan Secondary School will submit names of eligible students to the Lakeside Players.
- 2) Students must submit the Application Form by the required date; submissions must include an outline of the student's future educational plans.
- 3) The Lakeside Players will inform the school by May 9th, 2014.
- 4) The successful student has until June 30th, 2015 to claim the Bursary, and must provide proof of payment and registration to a post secondary institution.
- 5) Failure to claim within the time frame will forfeit receipt of the Bursary.
- 6) Upon claiming and acceptance by the Lakeside Players, the student will receive a cheque in the amount of the Bursary payable to the institution of their choice.
