Scholarship program

Catalyst Paper's scholarship program is designed to provide assistance with the financial needs of high school graduates entering their first year at a **public** university, community college or institute of technology.

Four scholarships are available in total, valued at a maximum of \$1000 each.

Who's eligible

To be eligible, the applicant must be planning to become a full-time student at a technical institute, community college or accredited **public** university, following high school graduation and receipt of the award. Deferment of one academic year is permitted where the applicant is participating in a recognized Grade 12 student exchange program.

The scholarship

Four scholarships to cover the student's first year tuition (up to a maximum of \$1000 for a technical institute, accredited public university or community college) will be granted to students upon graduating from a high school in the area where Catalyst is a major employer. Applicants must be graduating in 2017.

Completed application forms and full transcripts of marks from previous year of study completed, plus interim transcripts for the current year should be returned to that address. Applications must be received by May 1, 2017. Those received after the deadline will not be considered.

A committee selects the successful applicants. The committee members are representatives from the company. The decision of the selection committee is final.

Please answer all questions and submit required documentation. We do not require references. Incomplete applications will not be considered for scholarships.

Announcement of winners will be made by telephone to your high school Scholarship Committee and at your awards ceremony.
