

## SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Application deadline: May 1, 2020

Catalyst Crofton's scholarship program is designed to provide assistance with the financial needs of high school graduates entering their first year at a public university, community college or institute of technology.

Catalyst Crofton is offering six scholarships, valued at \$1,000.00 each. To be eligible the applicant must be a dependent of a Catalyst employee or retired associate residing in British Columbia who is planning to become a full-time student at a technical institute, community college or accredited public university, following high school graduation and receipt of the award.

In addition to the six scholarships that Catalyst Crofton is offering to dependents of Catalyst employees or retired associates residing in British Columbia, we are offering six scholarships valued at \$1,000.00 each, which will be awarded to qualified applicants in the First Nations communities in our area. To be eligible, the applicant must be a recognized status member of Cowichan Tribes First Nation, Halalt First Nation, Lake Cowichan First Nation, Lyackson First Nation, Penelakut First Nation, or Stz'uminus First Nation or status Inuit or Metis living in the community, who is planning to become a full-time student at a technical institute, community college or accredited public university, following high school graduation and receipt of the award.
