ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. A Member in good standing, Son, Daughter, or Legal Dependent of a Member in good standing or of a retired or deceased Member who were in good standing with United Steelworkers, Local 1-1937 or the legacy Local Unions.**
- 2. Currently graduating from a Secondary School.**
- 3. Must be planning to enroll in a Public Post-Secondary Institution as a fulltime student in the September following graduation.**
- 4. Vocational or Academic Programs are acceptable at any recognized Public Institution (College, Polytech, Institute of Technology or University).**
- 5. A short essay (maximum 500 words) on the topic:**
“The purpose of a Trade Union: Are Today’s Unions fulfilling that purpose or have they lost sight of it?”
- 6. Transcript for Grades 11 & 12.**
- 7. Deadline for Application is May 1st in any calendar year.**
