



BOB FREER, ERNIE FREER, JACK MUMM, SYD THOMPSON & BILL WILSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. United Steelworkers, Local 1-1937 has \$5,000.00 available for Scholarships. Amounts to be determined by the Scholarship Selection Committee. There will be a minimum of four (4) Scholarships awarded.
2. The Scholarships are available to:
 - Sons, Daughters, Grandchildren and Legal Dependents of Members in good standing or of retired or deceased Members who were in good standing with United Steelworkers, Local 1-1937 or the legacy Local Unions (1-71, 1-80, 1-118, 1-363, 1-217, 1-2171), who will be graduating from Secondary School this year and wish to further their education at a Public Post-Secondary Institution.
 - Members in good standing with United Steelworkers Local 1-1937 who will be graduating from Secondary School this year and wish to further their education at a Public Post-Secondary Institution.
3. Students must have completed Grade 12.
4. Students must enrol at a public Post-Secondary Institution in the September following graduation, either academic or vocational in nature.
5. An essay from the Applicant is required on the topic:
“The purpose of a Trade Union: Are Today’s Unions fulfilling that purpose or have they lost sight of it?”
6. **Application Form, Essay and documents must be completed and forwarded** to the Financial Secretary of United Steelworkers, Local 1-1937 (mailing address: 202-1509 Cliffe Avenue, Courtenay, B.C. V9N 2K6) **no later than May 1st of the current year.** United Steelworkers, Local 1-1937 reserves the right to withhold the scholarship if no Candidate has sufficiently high standing.
7. The winners of these scholarships must produce sufficient proof of enrolment in a recognized public Post-Secondary Institution before receiving the scholarship.
8. **Applications received without the Local Union application form and essay will be considered incomplete.**
